

Franks IPA

An IPA with more hops and more bitterness than usual from Grauballe Bryghus. Hopped with First Gold and Centennial, which gives an underlying, but still characteristic taste of hops. Dry hopped with Citra adds a pleasant freshness.

Slightly hazy, golden-amber with a small, white head. Fruity aroma with caramel malts, sweet, exotic fruits and a floral note. A subdued aroma. Taste is bitter. Medium body with a creamy texture and an average carbonation. Finishes dry and light bitter with fruits and caramel.

Matured in the bottle with a natural content of yeast. Unfiltered.
